AZERBAIJAN

Two **Long-billed Dowitchers** *Limnodromus scolopaceus* Liman (10 km north of Lankaran) 31 Jan (first record).

CYPRUS

A female **Red-crested Pochard** *Netta rufina* and 13 young Mia Milia STP/Haspolat STP 3 Jun and a pair **Ferruginous Ducks** *Aythya nyroca* plus eight young there the same day. Two **Black Storks** *Ciconia nigra* cape Apostolos Andreas/Zafer Burnu 12 Jan circled over the cape and then out over the Klides islands. A **Little Bustard** *Tetrax tetrax* Patriki/Tuzluca 6 Jan (fourth record, Plate 1). 13 **Pied Avocets** *Recurvirostra avosetta* Neapolis/Gülseren wetland 1 Apr was a high count. 18 **Black-bellied Sandgrouse** *Syrrhaptes orientalis*

Rizokarpaso/Dipkarpaz village 12 Jan, 14 Kapoutil/Kalkanlı 3 Jan, 36 Syrianochori/Yayla 11 Feb and an exceptional count of 54 Doğu Mesaoria/Mesarya 14 Feb. A Little Swift Apus affinis Aphendrika/Afendirka 17 Apr (20th record). The Pied Kingfisher Ceryle rudis Bogazi/Boğaz lagoons first reported Nov 2016 was present 1 Apr when another bird was at Famagusta/Glabsides. A Blue-cheeked Bee-eater Merops persicus Rizokarpaso/Dipkarpaz village 4 May was together with 100 European Bee-eaters M. apiaster. Four Lesser Kestrels Falco naumanni Rizokarpaso/Dipkarpaz village 12 May.

A melanistic **Crested Lark** *Galerida* [c.] *cristata* Kazivera/Gaziveren 13 Feb and a **Lesser Short-toed Lark** *Alaudala* (r.) *rufescens* cape Apostolos Andreas/Zafer Burnu 5–6

Apr (Plate 2). A Rose-coloured Starling Sturnus roseus Agios Amvrosio/Esentepe 7 Apr and two Livera/Sadrazamköy 5 May. A Pied Wheatear Oenanthe pleschanka carrying food Kayalar/Orga 10 Apr (vagrant). The first record of Desert Finch Rhodospiza obsoleta cape Apostolos Andreas/Zafer Burnu 5 Apr

(Plate 3), a male cape Greco 18 Apr and a male and female there 30 Apr–2 May. A Common Rosefinch Erythrina erythrina Livera/Sadrazamköy 18 May (vagrant). 4 Red-fronted Serins Serinus pusillus Livera/Sadrazamköy 24 Mar (vagrant).

EGYPT

Yellow Bittern Ixobrychus sinensis heard calling at mangroves Wadi Lahami 9 May. Three Cream-Coloured Coursers Cursorius cursor El Minya 28 Feb and ten flying north near Mallawi, central Egypt. Chestnut-bellied Sandgrouse Pterocles exustus seen again 10 May at presumed breeding area along the Nile near Mallawi. A Great Spotted Cuckoo Clamator glandularis near Minya 20 Feb and a single adult male Lesser Kestrel Falco naumani near Mallawi 13 Mar. A White-throated Kingfisher Halcyon smyrnensis Crocodile island, Luxor 3 Dec 2016 is further evidence of this species' southern expansion in recent years.

An Asian Desert Warbler Sylvia nana 23 Feb near Assiut and two 6 Mar in nearby area. A Black-throated Thrush Turdus [ruficollis] atrogularis Azure resort garden, Wadi Lahami, 25 Apr is the third record (Plate 4, previous 1833, 1983, both Sinai peninsula) and first for Africa proper. A male Hooded Wheatear Oenanthe monacha 22 Feb 30 km west of Tell el Amarna and a female seen there 24 Feb, indicating possible breeding. An African Pied Wagtail Motacilla aguimp 8 Dec 2016 just south of Aswan, the recently discovered most northerly breeding site for the species.

IRAN

The following records north of Ahwaz, Khuzestan province, Feb 2017. 11 Ruddy Shelducks Tadorna ferruginea Tavahe 6th. A Black Stork Ciconia nigra north of Mazrae Seh 8th and 200 Western White Storks C. c. ciconia Sade Shavar 2nd. 100 Great White Pelicans Pelecanus onocrotalus Nasiriey 5th. Blackwinged Kite Elanus caeruleus widespread, max 12 Mazrae Seh 8th. A Short-toed Snake Eagle Circaetus gallicus Tavahe 6th and 15 Greater Spotted Eagles Clanga clanga Tavahe 5th. Pallid Harriers Circus macrourus Mazrae Seh 6th, north of Seyed Abbas 7th and two south of Mazrae Seh 8th. A Sociable Lapwing Vanellus gregarius Mazrae Seh 2nd. Two Great Black-headed Gulls Ichthyaetus ichthyaetus Mazrae Seh 2nd, four Sade Shavar 6th. Two Daurian Shrikes Lanius [i.] isabellinus Helveh 3rd, two Ali Zoghayeh 4th, two Shavoor river 4th, three Karkeh Koor 5th, three Mazrae Seh 6th, two Tavahe 6th (six on 7th), six south of Mazrae Seh 8th, 1 Borvayeh 8th; c60% where sex determined were males (and no Turkestan Shrikes Lanius [i.] phoenicuroides recorded). Five Mesopotamian Crows Corvus (cornix) capellanus Helveh 3rd (Plate 5) and five Shadegan wildlife refuge 5th. 20 Oriental Skylarks Alauda gulgula north of Seyed Abbas

7th, nine Borvayeh 8th (clearly a regular winterer Khuzestan). A Hume's Leaf Warbler Phylloscopus humei Shushtar water mills 3rd. A Black-throated Thrush Turdus [ruficollis] atrogularis Helveh 3rd and Richard's Pipits Anthus richardi Mahmyeh 2nd and Mazrae Seh 6th. Additionally, a Caspian Plover Anarhynchus asiaticus Miankaleh, Mazandaran province, 25 Apr and a Rufous Turtle Dove Streptopelia (orientalis) meena there same day.

IRAQ

440 000 Eurasian Coots Fulica atra Delmej wetlands 16 Feb was a record number. 4500 Red-crested Pochards Netta rufina, 8800 Common Pochards Aythya farina, 6200 Ferruginous Ducks A. nyroca, and 11 000 Tufted Ducks A. fuligula during surveys 10–16 Feb in various wetlands in southern Iraq (Delmej, Bahr Al-Najaf, Sweibaat and west Hammar). During March three Black Storks Ciconia nigra (uncommon migrant) Dalmej wetland (one killed 1 Mar) and four over Qara Dagh, Kurdistan, 3 Apr.

Four nests of **Black-winged Kite** Elanus caeruleus found Diwaniya, Babylon, and Najaf 10 May (all middle Euphrates region, a range expansion for this species). **Eurasian Griffon Vultures** Gyps fulvus, **Steppe Eagles** Aquila nipalensis, two **Golden Eagles** A. chrysaetos and **Steppe Buzzards** Buteo b. vulpinus migrating 18 Feb over central and southern Iraq (total 77 individuals). Over 400 000 waders counted Delmej and other wetlands in southern Iraq during surveys mid Feb–Jun.

21 **Demoiselle Cranes** *Grus virgo* near Sulaymaniyah city 12 Apr. Two **Grey Plovers** *Pluvialis squatarola* west Hammar marshes 12 Feb (very rare). A **Eurasian Woodcock** *Scolopax rusticola* camera-trapped 11 Jan, Qara Dagh, Kurdistan. A breeding colony of *c*125 nests of **Collared Pratincole** *Glareola pratincola* on edge of Delmej marsh 15–27 May. During summer breeding surveys a new colony of **Slender-billed Gulls** *Chroicocephalus genei* discovered Dalmej wetland (230 nests); this species was also common during the surveys at other wetlands in southern Iraq. Six **Caspian**

Tern Hydroprogne caspia nests found Dalmej wetland 15–27 May together with 12 nests of Little Tern Sternula albifrons and Common Tern Sterna hirundo and a large breeding colony of Whiskered Terns Chlidonias hybrida.

35 nests of Namaqua Dove Oena capensis (and 22 juveniles) found in different areas of Acacia sp/Prosopis sp trees in new areas for this species in southern Iraq. Two nests of Eurasian Scops Owl Otus [s.] scops (with chicks) Diwaniya early June. A pair of Common Mynas Acridotheres tristis, 400 km north of where breeding was first proved in the 1990s and a few pairs of Red-backed Lanius collurio and Lesser Grey Shrikes L. minor also present in suitable breeding habitat although no breeding proved. Nests of Basra Reed Warbler Acrocephalus griseldis (Plate 6) and Great Reed Warbler A. [arundinaceus] arundinaceus found in Delmej wetland 2 Jun. Nine nests of Yellow-throated Sparrows Gymnoris xanthocollis (Plate 7) in a date palm and citrus plantation Diwaniya 18 May. High numbers of Black-headed Wagtails Motacilla (flava) feldegg near East Hammar marshes, southern Iraq, 27 April-some individuals frequently observed carrying either nesting material or food, the first breeding evidence for this species.

ISRAEL

The third record of **Taiga Bean Goose** Anser fabalis first found Agamon Hula Dec 2016 remained until end Feb. A Red-necked Grebe Podiceps grisegena Km 20, Eilat, 9 Mar (sixth record). 2533 Great Crested Grebes Podiceps cristatus on lake Galilee 13 Jan. Third record of Horned Grebe Podiceps auritus this winter Kfar Ruppin from 3 Jan (fifth record) while the Ma'agan Michael bird first recorded Dec remained to mid Jan. A Swinhoe's Petrel Oceanodroma monorhis off Eilat 14 Jun (eighth record). A Pink-backed Pelican Pelecanus rufescens Beit-shean valley 9 Apr-end Apr with an immature Yeruam lake 30 May-30 Jun and another Ein Hamifratz, Zvulun valley, 9 Jun (nintheleventh records). The wintering immature Lammergeier Gypaetus barbatus was last recorded 14 Jan at Gamla. The long-staying immature Bateleur Terathopius ecaudatus seen several locations until at least end of April.

Two different immatures seen migrating over Eilat mountains 26 and 27 Apr and another over Kisra, northwest Galilee, 15 May. *c*20 000 **Levant Sparrowhawks** *Accipiter brevipes* counted 27 Apr southern Arava, Eilat mountains and Eilat North Beach, with at least 13 000 28 Apr.

Two Demoiselle Cranes Grus virgo in Common Cranes G. grus flock Eilat mountains 15 Mar, seen migrating north following morning at Km 19. One Hula valley 30 Mar. A Eurasian Dotterel Charadrius morinellus among Cream-Coloured Coursers Cursorius cursor Nizzana 10 Apr was a very late record. Great Snipe Gallinago media: one Hamadiya fish ponds, Beit Shean valley 24–25 Apr. First Long-billed Dowitcher Limnodromus scolopaceus since 1984 Eilat Km20 saltpans 22 Apr-end Apr (second record). Single Whiteeyed Gulls Larus leucophthalmus Ma'agan Michael 26 May and Palmakhim 29 May (extremely rare Mediterranean).

Thick-billed Larks Ramphocoris clotbey Km 82, central Arava, 28 Jan. Single Dunn's Larks Eremalauda dunni Gaash 5 Apr and Hatzook beach 10-12 Apr (unusual at coast). Six Oriental Skylarks Alauda gulgula Kfar Rupin 24 Mar and one Yotvata 26 Mar. A Pallas's Leaf Warbler Phylloscopus (proregulus) proregulus Ein Gedi reserve 26 Jan–31 Mar (fifth record). One of the **Hume's** Leaf Warblers P. humei found Oct 2016 in Tel Aviv remained to end Feb while another Neot Smadar, south Negev, 24 Feb-31 Mar. Singles also Ein Gedi 15 Mar and Sde Boker 26 Mar onwards. A Yellow-browed Warbler P. inornatus Wadi Kelt, near Jerusalem, 20 Mar. A Paddyfield Warbler Acrocephalus agricola trapped Sde Boker 25 Apr (11th record) while a Western Grasshopper Warbler Locustella (n.) naevia singing Wadi Kelt 29 Mar was 13th record (first proven field record). An Eastern **Orphean Warbler** *Sylvia* [hortensis] crassirostris caught Og, northern Dead sea, 16 Jan had a zero fat score indicating first wintering record rather than extremely early migrant. Exceptional numbers of Ruppell's Warblers S. ruppeli 20-25 Mar with up to 40 birds seen many sites. One Red-breasted Flycatcher Ficedula (p.) parva Samar, south Arava, 15 Jan (extremely rare winter). Exceptional winter for **Basalt Wheatears** *Oenanthe* (lugens) warriae: five found in southern Negev and

southern Arava 1 Jan–16 Feb and one Eilat mountains 3 Feb (eighth–thirteenth records). First wintering record of **Pied Wheatear** *O. pleschanka* (a 1st winter male) Zeelim, northwestern Negev, 8 Jan. Single **Kurdish Wheatears** *O. xanthroprymna* mount Amsa 19 Jan, Orvim river, Golan Heights, 20 Jan, Eilat mountains 1 Apr. A **Blyth's Pipit** *Anthus godlevskii* Arsuf, near Tel Aviv, 11 Mar–16 Apr (sixth record) and an **Olive-backed Pipit** *A. hodgsoni* Dolev 2 Jan. One **Siberian Buff-bellied Pipit** *A. (rubescens) japonicus*, Urim, northwest Negev, 14 Jan and three Hamadiya 14 Mar.

Corrigendum: In the Israel section of Around the Region in *Sandgrouse* 39(1) **Taiga Bean Goose** *Anser fabalis* was described as having been recorded five times. IBRC has clarified that the December 2016 bird at Agamon Hula which remained to end February 2017 was in fact the fourth record there has also been a record of **Tundra Bean Goose** *A. serrirostris* Eilat 2007. IRDC also emphasises that the precise identification of Bean Goose in Israel is still tentative and that further work is required on this.

JORDAN

Late rains in the northeast during March caused additional flooding of Qa' Al Azraq (the shallow lake remained until mid summer) with several species unusually remaining to breed or use it as a feeding station. The last time this occurred was about 20 years agothe Qa' usually drying out before summer. Birds recorded 11 Jun included a Eurasian Spoonbill Platalea leucorodia, 40 Blackcrowned Night Herons Nycticorax nycticorax, three Squacco Herons Ardeola ralloides, one Grey Heron Ardea cinerea and 25 Little Egrets Egretta garzetta. In addition there were over 120 Black-winged Stilts Himantopus himantopus including juveniles, three pairs of breeding **Pied Avocets** Recurvirostra avosetta (Plate 8), over 80 Kentish Plovers Charadrius alexandrinus including juveniles and 11 Blacktailed Godwits Limosa limosa. Finally, six Slender-billed Gulls Chroicocephalus genei, one Caspian Gull Larus cachinnans, three/four pairs of **Gull-billed Terns** Gelochelidon nilotica with three chicks seen on small islands plus one/two pairs of **Little Terns** Sternula albifrons were recorded. Single Black-winged Kites Elanus caeruleus Shaumari and Al Azraq 13 Jan. A **Turkestan Shrike** Lanius [isabellinus] phoenicuroides (karelini type) was trapped and ringed east of Madaba 29 Apr (second record, Plate 9).

KUWAIT

The fifth record of Lesser Flamingo Phoeniconaias minor Sulaibikhat bay 4 Jan. Three Pygmy Cormorants Microcarbo pygmeus Jahra pools reserve (JPR) 20 Mar (fourth record, Plate 10) while a White-tailed Eagle Haliaeetus albicilla was there 25 Feb (also fourth record). Seven Sociable Lapwings Vanellus gregarius Sulaibiya pivot fields (SPF) 9 Jan increasing to 11 on 25 Jan while five Eurasian Golden Plovers Pluvialis apricaria were there 10 Feb. 12th record of Great Snipe Gallinago media at JPR 23 Apr. A Black-legged Kittiwake Rissa tridactyla JPR 11 Apr and another Al Kout mall 18 Apr (second and third

records). A **Rufous Turtle Dove** *Streptopelia* (*orientalis*) *meena* Mutla'a ranch 17 Nov 2016 while one **Pallid Scops Owl** *Otus brucei* was at Abraq Al Habari 8 Mar.

Three Calandra Larks Melanocorypha calandra Lyah reserve 10 Dec 2016 (third record). Five Pale Crag Martins Ptyonoprogne obsoleta JPR 4 Jan (tenth record). Third record of Eastern Bonelli's Warbler Phylloscopus

orientalis Mutla'a ranch 21 Mar (Plate 11). Two Hume's Leaf Warblers P. humei Abraq Al Habari 5 Jan and third record of Eurasian Wren Troglodytes troglodytes there 7 Feb. Fifth record Black Scrub Robin Cercotrichas podobe Mutla'a ranch 14 Apr. An Eversmann's Redstart Phoenicurus erythronotus Mutla'a ranch 15 Nov 2016 (Plate 12) and another Al Shallal's farm 19 Nov. Tenth record Hooded Wheatear Oenanthe monacha Jal Al Zor 17 Nov 2016 while fourth record Radde's Accentor Prunella ocularis Lyah reserve 31 Mar. A Masked Wagtail Motacilla (alba) personata Wafra farms 15 Nov 2016 and two Olivebacked Pipits Anthus hodgsoni Jahra farms 17 Nov 2016 (Plate 13). One Hawfinch C. coccothraustes Abraq Al Habari 16 Nov 2016 was second record.

LEBANON

A Great Crested Grebe Podiceps cristatus wintered off Tripoli/Mina city (first record at sea - formerly wintered in small numbers inland freshwater sites). Black-crowned Night Herons Nycticorax nycticorax bred for third year running in riparian forest, Anjar. No breeding record again at Aammiq. Over 300 Eurasian Golden Plovers Pluvialis apricaria flew high east-west 19 Jan Costa Brava/Khalde (new max). A Black-winged Pratincole Glareola nordmanni Palm islands 25 Mar (earliest spring record). Slender-billed Gulls Chroicocephalus genei regularly recorded along coast winter 2016/2017 (previously considered irregular winter visitor). Armenian Gulls Larus armenicus, previously considered vagrants, scarce but regular, mainly between Batroun and Tripoli. Sandwich Tern Sterna sandvicensis fairly common along coast winter 2016/2017 (previously considered extremely rare winter visitor).

A Eurasian Magpie Pica [p.] pica Ghalboun 9 Apr. Up to ten Goldcrests Regulus (r.) regulus above Chouwan, Jabal Moussa, 25 Nov 2016. Single Eastern Subalpine Warblers Sylvia [c.] cantillans Beirut port 24 Mar, Beirut waterfront 28–29 March (Plate 14), Byblos archeological site 4 Apr. A male White-Throated Robin Irania gutturalis near Hadath Baalbek (eastern slopes) 12 May.

OMAN

One Greater White-fronted Goose Anser albifrons Khawr Dhurf 20 Mar. The single Common Shelduck Tadorna tadorna recorded 29 Dec 2016 in the Raysut area increased to 22 by 5 Jan, reducing gradually until last record of one 5 May while the 15 Ruddy Shelducks T. ferruginea also gradually decreased until last record was of eight, 27 Mar. Up to 14 Cotton Pygmy Geese Nettapus coromandelianus at khawrs in Salalah area early Jan-21 Apr (last record). A Red-crested Pochard Netta rufina Saham STP 6 Jan. One White-faced Storm Petrel Pelagodroma marina (third record) and a Black-bellied Storm Petrel Fregetta tropica (fourth record) 80 km east of Al Qibliyah, Al Halaniyat islands, 3 Jun. A Yellow Bittern Ixobrychus sinensis Wadi Razit (upstream from Wadi Darbat) 4 May.

Single Black-winged Kites Elanus caeruleus Sun farms, Sohar, 17 Mar, Muscat airport 18 Apr, Al Mouj golf course, Seeb, 4 May. Three Crested Honey Buzzards Pernis ptilorhynchus Qurm park 2 Jan (unusual date northern Oman) while nine in Salalah area 12–18 Mar (one dark adult and eight light morph juveniles). Vultures seen Tawi Atayr area included 18 Eurasian Griffon Vultures Gyps fulvus 13 and 26 Mar (very high number), one Cinereous Vulture Aegypius monachus 13 Mar (eighth record) and six Lappet-faced Vultures Torgos tracheliotos. An adult pale

phase **Booted Eagle** *Hieraaetus pennatus* Jebel Shams 30 May (date suggested local breeding; no breeding records Arabia). A **Black Kite** *Milvus* [*migrans*] *migrans* Sohar 2 May and four **Black-eared Kites** *Milvus* [*migrans*] *lineatus* Raysut STP area 15 Mar.

Single White-breasted Waterhens Amaurornis phoenicurus Wadi Razit 4 and 7 May, Muscat Hills golf course, 11 Jun. Baillon's Crakes Zapornia (p.) pusilla Al Mughsayl 21 Mar (two), East Khawr 24 Mar, Wadi Razit 7 May. Second record Ruddybreasted Crake Z. fusca Wadi Razit 4 and 7 May. One 2cy **Demoiselle Crane** Anthropoides virgo Raysut STP 12-21 Mar. Three Pied Avocets Recurvirostra avosetta Raysut lagoons 21 Mar. The three Spur-winged Lapwings Vanellus spinosus reported 27 Dec 2016 Raysut STP remained in the Salalah area, with four birds 25 Feb, reducing to one by 14 Mar, last record 2 May. Three Pheasant-tailed Jacanas Hydrophasianus chirurgus East Khawr 12-14 Mar. The Long-toed Stint Calidris subminuta first reported East Khawr 18 Nov 2016 remained to 24 Mar. Two juvenile Creamcoloured Coursers Cursorius [c.] cursor Sun farms, Sohar, 10 Jun indicated probable breeding in the area and several fledged young Collared Pratincoles Glareola pratincola there on the same date. A **Common Gull** *Larus* [c.] canus Khawr Sallan, Sohar, 21 Mar. 150 Little Terns Sternula albifrons Khawr Dhurf 3 May (regular passage along Oman coast Apr but rare May).

Four **Pharaoh Eagle-Owls** Bubo ascalaphus Jebel Madar 5 May. 30+ Alpine Swifts Tachymarptis melba Salalah 14 Mar. 30 Bluecheeked Bee-eaters Merops persicus Sun farms, Sohar, 6 May and 50, 10 Jun but no breeding activity at the usual nest site area. A Eurasian Hobby Falco subbuteo seen on pelagic trip 60 km east of Ras al Hadd 4 Jun. Early Masked Shrike Lanius nubicus Ayn Jarziz 16 Feb. 50 Greater Hoopoe-Larks Alaemon alaudipes Dawqah 12 May (highest concentration since 2014). A Hume's Whitethroat Sylvia [curruca] althaea Barik 18 Feb (4th record), while a survey of Hayl al Jawari area (2300 m asl) of Jebel Akhdar, 26 Apr-31 May recorded a number of individuals singing and indicating imminent breeding. A Ring Ouzel Turdus torquatus Masirah island resort, 15-21 Feb (unusual away from Musandam/ Jebel Akhdar). 42 Black-throated Thrushes *T.* [ruficollis] atrogularis Sayq plateau 1 Jan (new max), 36 on 1 Mar. One Eversmann's Redstart Phoenicurus erythronotus Sayq plateau 1 and 29 Jan, probably one of the two wintering birds seen Nov-Dec 2016, and 20 'Central Asian' Black Redstarts *P.* (ochruros) phoenicuroides also there 1 Jan. A Masked Wagtail Motacilla (alba) personata Sur STP 4 Jan (unusual away from Sohar). A Little Bunting Emberiza pusilla Saham rubbish dump 17 Mar.

QATAR

Two adult and one juv Sacred Ibises Threskiornis [a.] aethiopicus (local feral population) Sailiya STP 11 Jun. A Blackwinged Kite Elanus caeruleus vociferus Irkayya farm 24-25 Feb (eighth record) while subadult Short-toed Snake Eagles Circaetus gallicus there 20 Feb, 26 Mar (same bird) and a juvenile 27 Apr. A juvenile Crested Honey Buzzard Pernis ptilorhynchus Doha golf course 22 Mar (fourth record). A Greater Spotted Eagle Clanga clanga in a kettle Al Shamal 5 May. Third record Bonelli's Eagle Aquila fasciata IF 13 May and 10-16 Jun. 14 Black Kites Milvus [migrans] migrans displaying characteristics of Black-eared Kite Milvus (migrans) lineatus) in a kettle Al Shamal 5 May. One dark and one pale morph Long-Legged Buzzard Buteo [r.] rufinus IF 16 Jan-11 Feb, two there 4 Mar and one in the Al Shamal kettle 5 May. A **Steppe Buzzard** *B. b. vulpinus* IF 12 May (fifth record) and first record Shikra Accipiter (badius) cenchroides Shamal coast 13 May. A juvenile **Allen's Gallinule** *Porphyrio* alleni IF 11 Jan (first record) and Corncrakes Crex crex Al Ruwais park, 13-20 May, one Shamal park and one Saudi border 20 May (Eighth-tenth records). A Spur-winged Lapwing Vanellus spinosus west Sailiya STP 23 Mar-9 Jun (second bird present 24 Mar (fourth record) while the ninth record of Sociable Lapwing V. gregarius IF 7 Jan. Two Eurasian Golden Plovers Pluvialis apricaria IF 24 Feb–4 Mar (fourth record). Four Creamcoloured Coursers Cursorius cursor IF 10 Jun.

First record **Brown-necked Raven** Corvus ruficollis Al Kharsaah 17–22 Jan. A **Pharaoh Eagle Owl** Bubo ascalaphus 10 Jun (location withheld). One **European Nightjar** Caprimulgus europaeus unwini IF 28 Apr and 12 **Egyptian Nightjars** C. aegyptius at day roost

near IF 10 Jun (cf 34 same date 2016). Three European Rollers Coracias garrulus IF 28 Apr. A female Amur Falcon Falco amurensis west Sailiya STP 9–13 Jun (fifth record).

A Basra Reed Warbler Acrocephalus griseldis Al Ruwais 20 May (first record) and the tenth record of Hume's Whitethroat Sylvia althaea IF 11 Apr. A Brahminy Starling Sturnia pagodarum south of Al Shamal 27 Mar was considered an escape. After the Nov 2016 influx, Black-throated Thrush [ruficollis] atrogularis numbers declined gradually until 3 Mar (IF). A Thrush Nightingale Luscinia luscinia Al Ruwais park 13 May (12th record) and up to 12 Eastern Nightingales L. (megarhynchos) golzii IF 28–29 Apr. A pair of Caspian Stonechats Saxicola maurus hemprichii IF 24 Feb and two different birds there 4 Mar (seventh & eighth records). An Eastern Black-eared Wheatear Oenanthe (hispanica) melanoleuca IF 11 Mar and an influx of Pied Wheatears O. [h.] pleschanka IF end Feb-11 Mar (at least) included two vittata birds. A Richard's Pipit Anthus richardi IF 18 Apr (seventh record) while a Trumpeter Finch Bucanetes githagineus Al Zowair north, 19 Apr, was the fourth record.

SAUDI ARABIA

An adult and juvenile Bewick's Swan Cygnus (columbianus) bewickii near Al Jawf 14-15 Dec 2016 with three more adults in the north of the Kingdom 19 Dec 2016 (second and third records). Four See-see Partridges Ammoperdix griseogularis, including a calling male, at a remote desert site two hours from Sakaka, Al Jawf province, 23 Apr, the first record for many years. A Striated Heron Butorides striata Al Khobar corniche 13 Jan (fifth record Eastern province; species spreading north up Gulf coast. A Goliath Heron Ardea goliath remained at King Abdullah University of Science and Technology, Thuwal, near Jeddah (KAUST) until at least 18 May with two present 6-19 Apr. A Macqueen's Bustard Chlamydotis macqueenii, a species in serious decline in the Eastern province, was near Al Hassa 6 Jan. A juvenile Bonelli's Eagle Aquila fasciata Dhahran hills 25 Feb (fourth record Eastern province). An overwintering immature male Crested Honey Buzzard Pernis ptilorhynchus Deffi park 16 Dec 2016 and up to eight wintering birds in Dhahran until mid Feb, a single remaining until 12 Apr. An adult **Verreaux's Eagle** *Aquila verreauxii* bottom of Raydah escarpment 31 Mar.

350 **Northern Lapwings** Vanellus vanellus Haradh 13 Jan second largest flock recorded. 26 **Spur-winged Lapwings** *V. spinosus* Haradh pivot fields 13 Jan with six there 3 Feb. Two further birds Sabkhat Al Fasl, Jubail (SAF) 7 Apr, one staying until 27 May at least. A single Haradh 21 April appeared to be defending a territory aggressively from other birds suggesting possible breeding. A record 24 Red-wattled Lapwings V. indicus Shaybah water ponds 14 Feb (previously regarded as vagrant to Eastern province). Seven Sociable Lapwings V. gregarius Haradh 13 Jan where they have wintered since 2016, at least five remained until 3 Feb, only the third record for the Eastern province (wintering at this site since 2016). The bird first recorded 21 Nov 2016 at KAUST wintered in the area until 23 Feb at least. A **Great Spotted Cuckoo** Clamator glandarius at KAUST 4 Feb while a Pallid Scops Owl Otus brucei in wadi south of Zulfi 20 Dec 2016. A White-throated Kingfisher Halcyon smyrnensis Dhahran 20 Jan and the Pied Kingfisher Ceryle rudis, first recorded 23 Sep 2016 at KAUST remained until 23 May. A Black-crowned Tchagra Tchagra senegalus was at the bottom of the Raydah escarpment 31 Mar while two Arabian Magpies Pica (p.) asirensis Sallal al-Dahna, Tanoumah, 1–2 Apr. 20 Blanford's Larks Calandrella blanfordi Talea'a valley 31 Mar-2 Apr (Plate 15) and

15 **Oriental Skylarks** Alauda gulgula SAF 10 Feb. A **Basra Reed Warbler** Acrocephalus griseldis SAF 26 May, a **Moustached Warbler** *A. melanopogon* KAUST 19 Apr (first for site) while a large fall of migrants at Sarrar 24 Feb included the first record of **Thick-billed Warbler** *Arundinax aedon*.

An adult male Common Blackbird Turdus merula SAF 29 Dec 2016-20 Jan with a female there 29 Jan. Four **Black-throated Thrushes** *T*. atrogularis (an adult male and three first year males) at Deffi park 20 Jan, first record for the Eastern province since the 1980s, increasing to 12, (two adult males, two adult females and eight first year males) 27 Jan-10 Feb (Plate 16) remaining until 10 Feb—all records part of the influx into Arabia winter 2016-2017. Two **Redwings** *T. iliacus* Deffi park 27 Jan (tenth record). A pair of Black Scrub Robins Cercotrichas podobe and one single near Sarrar 24 Feb (Plate 17) with additional records from the Al Hassa area indicate that this species is now resident, mainly on farms, in Eastern province. A female Eversmann's Redstart Phoenicurus erythronotus SAF 29 Jan (Plate 18) was first record since 2000. One Sinai Rosefinch Carpodacus synoicus Yanbu STP dump 4 Feb was well south of its normal range.

TURKEY

Turkey experienced a cold winter 2016/2017 which resulted in a number of northern species sighted. Five Lesser White-fronted Geese Anser erythropus found during crane surveys Akyatan Gölü, Adana, 24 Jan (second record for site). Red-breasted Geese Branta ruficollis seen at three sites: two Büyükçekmece Gölü, İstanbul, 24 Jan, one Kamil Abduş Gölü 4–12 Feb and a remarkably late individual Kuyucuk Gölü, Kars, 13–17 May. An adult Long-tailed Duck Clangula hyemalis İğneada harbour 28 Jan-4 Feb. Common Scoters Melanitta nigra at two sites 20 km apart along the Black sea coast, Istanbul, two at Karaburun 28 Jan and three Kilyos 17 Feb. Single Horned Grebes Podiceps auritus Büyükçekmece Gölü 3 Feb and Kamil Abduş Gölü, 12-19 Feb.

A Lesser Flamingo Phoeniconaias minor Kulu Gölü 10–30 Apr was probably the returning bird from previous years (last recorded 5 Apr 2016). It was accompanied by a possible hybrid Greater/Lesser Flamingo Phoenicopterus roseus/Phoeniconaias minor (Plate 19). A Grey-headed Swamphen

poliocephalus Ekşisu Porphyrio Sazlığı, Erzincan, 30 Apr was at least 340 km from the nearest breeding area and was also in the middle of the country at 1146 m asl. A Redwattled Lapwing Vanellus indicus Karkamış (Euphrates) 19 May (most westerly record). A single Herring Gull Larus argentatus Rize 3 Jan – this species now occurs regularly on the Black sea coast. A 3rd year Great Blackbacked Gull L. marinus Küçük Çekmece Gölü, İstanbul, 29 Jan while an adult Lesser Blackbacked Gull Larus fuscus intermedius was at the Yellow-legged Gull L. michahellis colony at Oymapınar Barajı, Antalya. Five Pomarine Skuas Stercorarius pomarinus off Erdemli, Mersin, 16 Jan indicates a regular wintering population off the Mediterranean coast while a Long-tailed Jaeger S. longicaudus Milleyha, Antakya, 12 Feb.

A Bohemian Waxwing Bombycilla garrulus İğneada, Kırklareli, 28 Jan. Whiteeared Bulbuls Pycnonotus leucotis Avcılar, İstanbul, 26 Apr, were considered escapes. A Grasshopper Warbler Locustella naevia Köyceğiz Gölü 10 Apr and a Cyprus Warbler Sylvia melanothorax Göksu delta 18 Mar. At least three Common Mynas Acridotheres tristis at Fuar, İzmir, during February. A wintering male Common Redstart Phoenicurus phoenicurus Subaşı, Antakya, 7 Jan and one Cyprus Wheatear Oenanthe cypriaca Göksu

delta 25 Mar. The seventh record of **Blyth's Pipit** *Anthus godlewskii* Milleyha, Hatay, 5 Feb (third record at location). An influx of **Trumpeter Finches** *Bucanetes githagineus* this spring: singles Göksu delta 22 Mar, Çorum, central Turkey, 14 May and Rize, Black sea coast, 14–17 May.

UNITED ARAB EMIRATES

The female Red-crested Pochard Netta rufina first seen Al Ain 29 Nov 2016 seen 6 Jan, two others Al Wathba wetland reserve 14 Jan, one remaining to 4 Feb and another Al Warsan lakes 17 Feb (19th & 20th records). 100 Wilson's Storm Petrels Oceanites oceanicus 50-60 km offshore Kalba 9 Jun and a Swinhoe's Storm Petrel Hydrobates monorhis (eighth record) on another trip 19 May. Two Sooty Shearwaters Puffinus griseus on an earlier trip from Kalba 9 Apr with an inshore bird off Bidiyah 29 Apr. Other trips produced four Flesh-footed Shearwaters Ardenna carneipes 9 Jun, 30 Jouanin's Petrels Bulweria fallax 7 Apr (earliest spring record) and 80 on 5 May. A Red-billed Tropicbird Phaethon aethereus off Kalba beach 26 May, a very rare east coast inshore record. A Eurasian Bittern Botaurus stellaris Hatta 6 Apr. One Eastern Cattle Egret Bubulcus coromandus Ajman STP 1 Apr (fifth record) and two Wamm farms 19-27 May (considered same fourth record as

previous sightings at this site). A Dalmatian Pelican Pelecanus crispus Umm al Qaiwain 1 Mar and Ras al Khor 4 Mar (third record). Single Black-winged Kites Elanus caeruleus Lahab fields 18 Feb, Hamraniyah fields 3 Mar, Safa park, Dubai, 6 Apr. 36 Greater Spotted Eagles Clanga clanga Ras al Khor 28 Jan plus a Steppe Eagle Aquila nipalensis which stayed to early Feb, single Steppe Eagle Dubai desert conservation resort 23 Mar. A male Hen Harrier Circus [cyaneus] cyaneus Ras al Khor 1 Jan.

Two Sociable Lapwings Vanellus gregarius Wamm farms 17 Feb and a Great Snipe Gallinago media there 18 Feb (12th record). Five Black-winged Pratincoles Glareola nordmanni Hamraniyah fields 2 Mar (28th record), last recorded 2014. A Black-legged Kittiwake Khor al Beida 3 Feb (seventh record). A Sooty Tern Onychoprion fuscatus well offshore from Fujairah 5 May and another 9 Jun; a Roseate Tern Sterna dougallii on Fujairah beach 5 May. One Common Woodpigeon Columba palumbus Al Ain 5 Apr (seventh record if wild, there are frequent

apparent escapes in the Dubai area). Three Asian Koels Eudynamys [s.] scolopaceus Al Ain 1 Apr (record number). A Great Spotted Cuckoo Clamator glandarius Wamm farms 4 Feb (fifth record) and a Common Cuckoo Cuculus canorus (dead) Abu Dhabi 5 Jan (very rare mid winter). 11 European Nightjars Caprimulgus europaeus Madinat Zayed 28 Apr and five Mamzar 29 Apr. Egyptian Nightjars C. aegyptius present at Ajban breeding site, Abu Dhabi emirate, 17 Jun (Plates 20 & 21). One Alpine Swift Tachymarptis melba Sila'a peninsula 28 Apr and a Little Swift Apus affinis Ajman STP 27–28 Jan.

The wintering **Bay-backed Shrike** Lanius vittatus Lulu island first seen 1 Dec 2016 remained to 20 Jan at least while singles at Masafi 24 Mar, Palm Jumeirah park, Dubai, 30 Mar–14 Apr and Mushrif Palace gardens, Abu Dhabi, 30 Apr. A late **Bimaculated Lark** Melanocorypha bimaculata Wamm farms 7 Apr. Single **Wire-tailed Swallows** Hirundo smithii 3 Feb Wamm farms and Warsan lakes and two Al Ain 14–20 Mar (16–18th records). A **Eurasian Crag Martin** Ptyonoprogne rupestris

Mamzar park 12 May. One singing Siberian Chiffchaff Phylloscopus [collybita] tristis Emirates Palace hotel, Abu Dhabi, 28 Apr. A Common Grasshopper Warbler Locustella naevia Abu Dhabi 23 Mar and a singing bird Wamm farms 7 Apr. A Ring Ouzel Turdus torquatus Jebel Dhanna 24 Feb remaining until early March. After the Nov-Dec 2016 influx, Black-throated Thrushes T. atrogularis widespread with peak counts of up to 12 Lulu island and seven Mamzar park. A Redwing T. iliacus Mushrif Palace gardens 3-4 Feb (ninth record). A European Robin Erithacus rubecula Mamzar park 28 Mar-early Apr was a late record. A male Eversmann's Redstart Phoenicurus erythronotus Sharjah 1 Jan (fifth record this winter) while the Wadi Bih bird first seen Dec 2016 remained to 20 Jan. A Caspian Stonechat Saxicola [torquatus] maurus hemprichii at Sila'a 17 Feb. A Common Linnet Linaria cannabina Safa park, Dubai, 25 Apr (fifth record, first since 2005). One Common Reed Bunting Emberiza schoeniclus Wathba wetland reserve 18 Mar (ninth record).
