#### **CYPRUS**

- Oriental Turtle Dove Streptopelia orientalis.

  An individual shot Larnaca area mid December 2016. Accepted from photographs. First record.
- Namaqua Dove *Oena capensis*. A male Paphos, 22 April 2016 (J Higgins). Fifth record.
- Little Swift Apus affinis. One Akrotiri gravel pits, 16 December 2016 (T Reeves) and one Phasouri reed beds, 25 September 2016 (M Smith). 18th–19th records.
- Little Bustard Tetrax tetrax. One Paphos headland, 28 December 2016 (J Wozencroft) and another Mandria (Paphos), 31 December 2016 (R Cheke, J Coles, R Borello). Third & fourth recently accepted records although previous anecdotal reports of shot birds.
- Levant Sparrowhawk Accipiter brevipes. One juvenile Phasouri beehives, Akrotiri, 19 September 2016 (M Smith). Rare, less than annual passage migrant.
- Steppe Grey Shrike Lanius (meridionalis) pallidirostris. One Akrotiri salt lake, 31 March 2016 (J Stylianou, B Harrison, T Reeves), another there 26 October–18 November 2016 (W Stacey, T Reeves) and another cape Greco 21 November–15 December 2016 (N Tuinov). 12th–14th records.

- Bar-tailed Lark *Ammomanes cinctura*. One Akrotiri gravel pits, 2–3 April 2016 (S Spyrou). Fourth record.
- Horned Lark *Eremophila alpestris*. A male and female, Artemis trail, Troodos, 25 October 2016 (B Robertson). Fourth record.
- 'Caucasian Chiffchaff' Phylloscopus [collybita] lorenzii. One Avagas gorge, Paphos, 6 November 2016 (C & D Lamsdell). Third record.
- Eastern Bonelli's Warbler Phylloscopus [bonelli] orientalis. One Souni, Limassol, 16 August 2016 (J Neal). Quite common in spring but rare in autumn (all autumn records considered by CRC).
- Dusky Warbler Phylloscopus fuscatus. Two Paphos sewage treatment plant, 8 November–2 December 2016 (C Richardson). Second record (first 1967).
- Yellow-browed Warbler Phylloscopus inornatus. One Platania, Troodos, 4–16 November 2016 (J Stylianou) and another Larnaca, 20 November 2016 (C & D Lamsdell). 16th–17th records.
- Olive-tree Warbler Hippolais olivetorum. One Tsada, Paphos, 24 May 2016 (C Richardson) and one Nicosia, 12 September 2016 (J Stylianou). 15th–16th records since 1994.
- Asian Desert Warbler Sylvia [nana] nana. One Anarita park, Paphos, 26–30 March 2016 (R Shiret, J Willson). 16th record.
- **Ménétries's Warbler** *Sylvia mystacea*. A female Agios Theodoros, Larnaca, 8 April 2016 (H von Rohr). Third record.
- Ring Ouzel Turdus torquatus. Two Troodos, 5 November 2014 (N Bucknell). 13 records 1993—end 2016.
- European Pied Flycatcher Ficedula [hypoleuca] hypoleuca. One Troodos 30 August 2016 (S Christodoulides, A P Leventis). Rare in autumn (autumn records are considered by CRC).
- Semi-collared Flycatcher Ficedula semitorquata. A female Asprokremmos dam, Paphos, 12–19 September 2016 (D & J Walker, I & K Bloomer). First autumn record (fairly common spring migration).
- Red-breasted Flycatcher Ficedula [parva] parva. One cape Greco, 7 April 2016 (C

Kehoe); one ringed Larnaca salt lake, 19 September 2016 (A Kirschel, M Moysi); one ringed Prodromos, Troodos, 1 October 2016 (A Kirschel, M Moysi). Rare, less than annual passage migrant, possibly becoming more frequent.

'Caspian Stonechat' Saxicola maurus hemprichi. A female Karpasia peninsula, 24 March 2016 (C Richardson). Rare passage migrant, less than annual.

'Western Siberian Stonechat' Saxicola maurus. A male cape Greco, 4 March 2016 (J Stylianou); different bird there 12–13 March 2016 (J Stylianou, F Georgiades); one Karpasia peninsula, 2 April 2016 (M Hellicar, K & R Howard). Rare, less than annual passage migrant.

White-crowned Wheatear Oenanthe leucopyga. A male sea caves, cape Greco, 7 May 2016 (CRC). Ninth record.

Rock Sparrow Petronia petronia. Five Syngrasis, Famagusta, 24–27 November 2016 (G Constantinou, B Gokeri). At least eleven previous records.

Olive-backed Pipit Anthus hodgsoni. One Nicosia, 6 November 2016 (V Vasiliou). Sixth record.

Siberian Buff-bellied Pipit Anthus (rubescens) japonicus. One Nicosia, 8 November 2016 (S Christodoulides); one Akhna dam 19 November–early December 2016 (C & D Lamsdell). Fourth & fifth records.

Common Rosefinch Carpodacus erythrinus. Two ringed Polis reedbeds, 24 October 2016 (M Jeffery, M Preston, B Roberts). 12th record.

Pine Bunting Emberiza leucocephalos. A female Livadi tou Pashia, Troodos, 4 November 2016 (D & J Walker); two Troodos, 15 November 2016 (C & D Lamsdell); three, Giant Junipers, Troodos, 17 November 2016 (C Richardson). At least 13 records.

**Rustic Bunting** *Emberiza rustica*. First winter female Paphos STP, 24 November 2016 (J Stylianou). First record.

Cinereous Vulture Aegypius monachus. One immature Mudawwara, 19 January 2017 (R Isaksson). Eighth record.

Common Buzzard Buteo buteo buteo. Two Madaba STP, 15 November 2016, one staying till 7 March 2017. One Kafrein dam, Jordan valley, 13 December 2016 (F Khoury). Second–fourth records of nominate subspecies.

Daurian Shrike Lanius (isabellinus) isabellinus. One adult airport area, east of Madaba, 29–30 April 2017 (F Khoury). First confirmed record after taxonomic separation.

**Redwing** *Turdus iliacus*. One south of Aqaba, 25 November 2016 (A Riad). Sixth record.

In the *Data collection* section (p114), end of the first sentence should read "... in all four seasons (12 months)."
